The project saw GEM strip out the existing space for VANRATH's new 8th floor head office prior to the completion of all fit out requirements.



Located in Belfast's Victoria House on Gloucester Street, the new office covers 6,000 sq ft and features an open working area for around 60 staff, interview and meeting rooms, a modern communal kitchen area, as well as timber privacy screens to create break out areas.

The bright and modern-look office includes an impressive reception area with a large feature lightbox, whilst each client meeting area and the boardroom have colourful wall graphics. A lightbox was also used to create a quirky ceiling feature above the team meeting area.

In addition to all workspace and client areas, GEM also fitted a separate client hospitality area.

The 14-week project included full electrical and mechanical installation work and the manufacturing of all fitted office furniture.



GEM spent 18 weeks on site from January, 2021 completely transforming the 15,000 sq ft Lobby Area and Suites within the Citypark Complex.

This site presented many challenges as Citypark is located at the bustling edge of Glasgow city centre and had a live environment which was tenanted throughout the entire transformation process.

GEM spent 16 weeks on site transforming the ground floor of the iconic Capella Building, 60 York Street in Glasgow. The works generally comprised of the sub-division of an existing retail space within the ground floor complex to create both male and female communal shower and changing facilities.

Access to the unit was created by introducing a knock through into the existing lift lobby and into the rear fire escape staircase. In conjunction with the changing facilities, GEM created access corridors, a kitchenette and storage room to turn the building shell into a practical, functional and modern space befitting the iconic building.

This was no mean feat as the works were quite extensive and included structural alterations, steelwork installation, new services, flooring and fit- out works.

As this was a live site with tenants in situ and intrusive works required throughout the 11 storey building GEM meticulously planned all disruptive works during 'out of hours' and on 'night shift' to minimise any potential disruption to the Tenants.

As the Capella Building is in a prominent city centre site, logistically this provided challenges with site accessibility. GEM carefully coordinated the logistics 'out-of-hours' in order to maximise access for site clearance, mechanical access and deliveries.



There was a sharp 4-week programme of works including partitioning, electrical and mechanical works, bespoke joinery, tiling, flooring and decoration works.

GEM's skilled and dedicated fit out team created intricate custom three-dimensional layered wall panels which offer a unique feature to compliment freestanding timber privacy screens. GEM also created a circular bespoke LED illuminated suspended lighting raft offering an eye-catching focal point within the restaurant.

All of which gives the restaurant a modern twist upon a vintage and retro based design which oozes both culture and class, offering the restaurant a seamless inclusion into its glamourous location.

Essential fire safety works were completed during the works and excellent coordination was required to ensure that all fire and life


safety systems remained fully operational, whilst not impacting on the Cinema showing times.
